




To use Hoopla on your Kindle Fire, **download the Hoopla Digital app** from the App store.






With your account created, **tap Sign Up** to agree to the terms and conditions.






The Home tab is the first page you see after logging in. Here you can see the number of titles you have left to borrow and buttons for the different types of media available. **Tap a type of media** to browse its available titles.




You will be taken to the Recommended tab where you can **swipe left or right** or tap to change to a different tab.



If you want to refine the titles recommended to you, scroll to the bottom of the page where you can **“Tap here to edit your recommendation settings”**. Then **select genres** you want Hoopla to recommend. To return to the Homepage, **tap the left-facing arrow** at the top of the screen.




Swipe up or down to see the featured titles for each of the available types of media. When you find something interesting, **tap the title** to see more information.






If you choose to favorite a title and want to find it again, go to the home screen and **tap the Favorites tab.**




