





hoopla is a groundbreaking digital media service offered by your local public library that allows you to borrow


In the box that pops up, **click the Choose your local library dropdown menu**, **enter the name of your library**, and **click your library** when it appears below. **Click Next** when you're done.




Enter your library card and PIN, and then click Next.




Enter and confirm your email and a password. Then click Next.



Finally, **enter your email and password**, and then **click the Log In! button**.




You can now use Hoopla. You will start on the home page, which shows all the titles you currently have borrowed and recently returned. To personalize your Hoopla experience, **click Settings**.






And **click the genres** that interest you for each type of media. Hoopla will use your selection to suggest media you might want to see. When you are finished, **click Done** at the top of the page.




To find a title, you can **enter a term in the search bar** and limit your search to a type of media when you **click the dropdown menu in the search bar** and **select a media type**.



If you want to explore available titles, **click the Browse dropdown menu** and **select a media type**.




Hoopla uses four tabs to suggest titles—Recommended, Featured, Popular, and Categories. **Click a tab** to view the suggested titles.

Lizzie Borden took an axe, and gave her mother forty whacks. When she saw what she had done, she gave her father forty-one. Or did she? In this riveting debut novel, *See What I Have Done*, Sarah Schmidt recasts one of the most spellbinding murder cases of all time into a sensitive and humane portrait of two sisters caught inside a volatile household—and what it means to be free and truly loved. Had she been in the barn or the pear arbor to escape the stifling heat of the house? Before or after she last spoke to her stepmother? Were they really gone and would everything be better now? Through the overlapping perspectives of the unreliable Lizzie, her older sister Emma, the housemaid Bridget, and the enigmatic stranger Benjamin, we return to what happened on that fateful day.
