

**Take Storytime To Go!**  
Grab a storytime to go packet and get rhyming at home!

Read a book with the first letter of your child's name in the title.  
Trace the letter and discuss the sound it makes.  
Talk about other words start with the same letter.

Read a book with your little one and someone you miss. Stay safe by reading over the phone or using video chat.  
Or record a video of you reading a story with your little one and send it to someone you love!

**Grab a book, grab your little one and head outside to share a story under the open sky!**

**Teach Your Little One a Rhyme!**  
Dig deep and think of rhymes from your childhood to say with your little one.

Talk about 5 book covers with your child. Ask:  
What's on the cover?  
What do they think will happen in the story?  
What colors are used?  
Are there animals, people, trucks on the cover?

**Sing together!**  
Encourage your child to participate with making up lyrics and go with it!

Make a card for a family member, neighbor, or friend.  
Encourage your little one to help decorate the card and make sure they sign their name!
